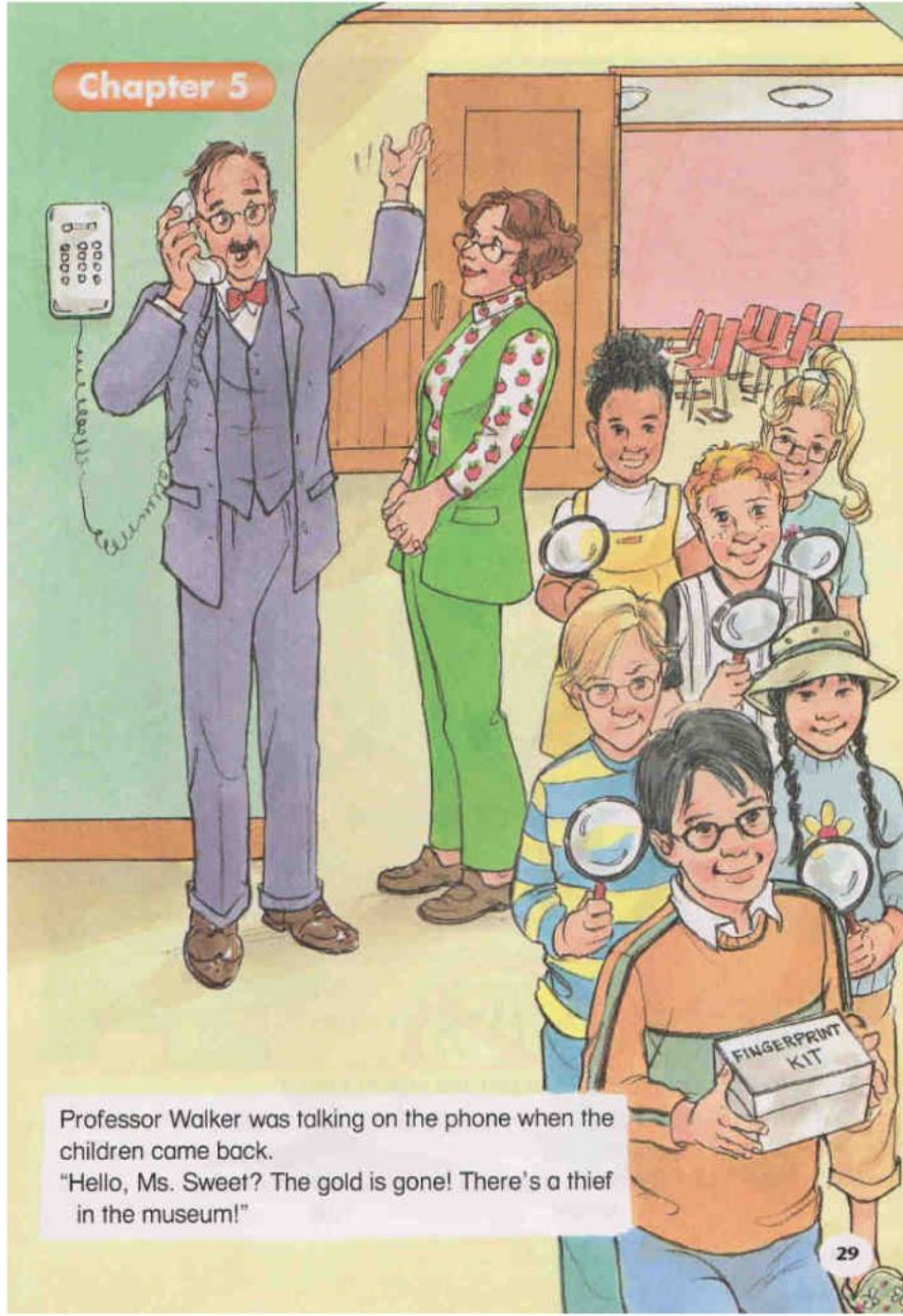
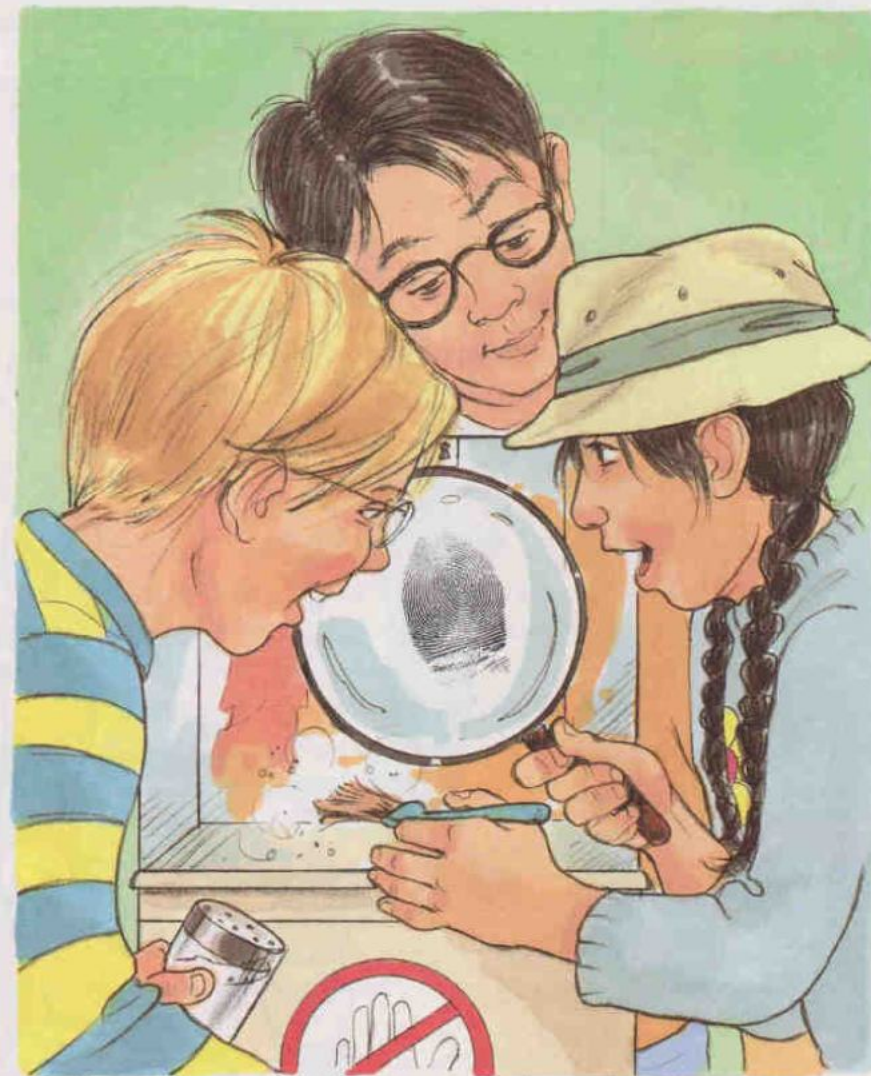


Chapter 5

Meanwhile, Annie and Ted followed Digger downstairs.



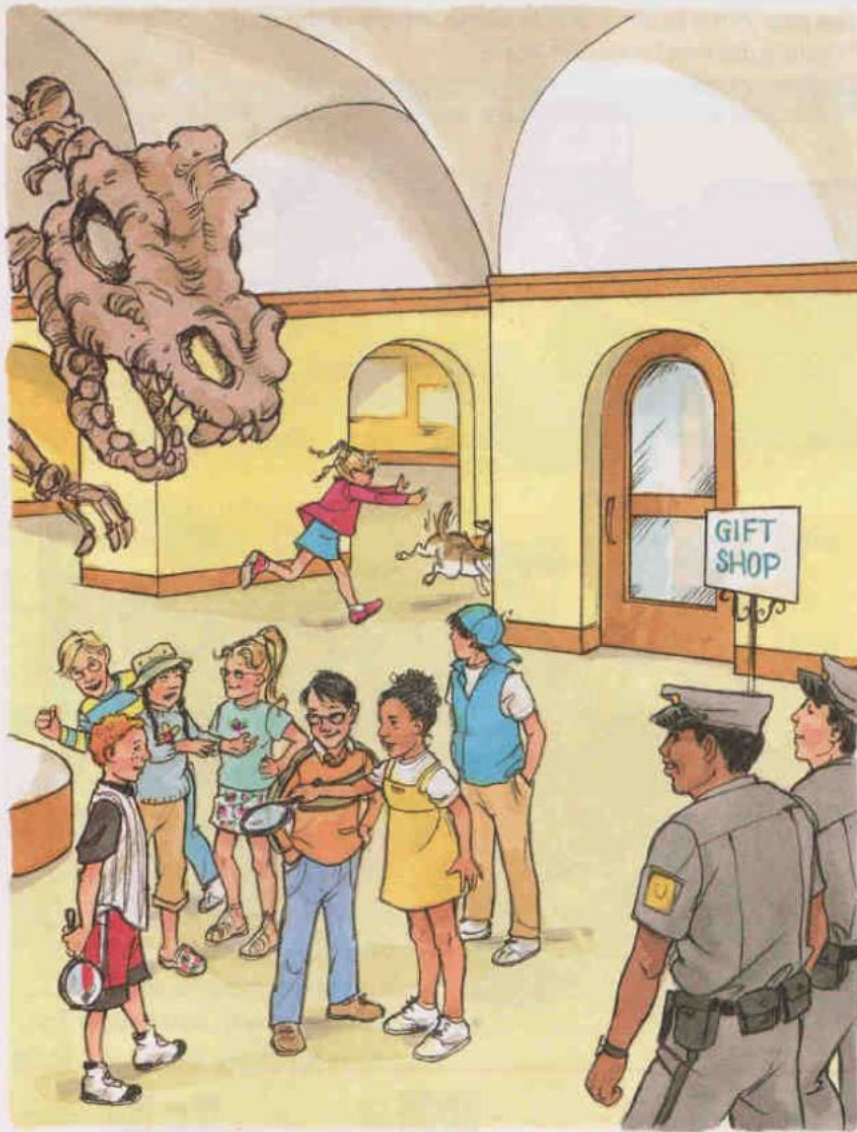
Digger went to the Costumes Exhibit. He barked at the empty chair.

"Quick! Let's find everyone!" said Ted.

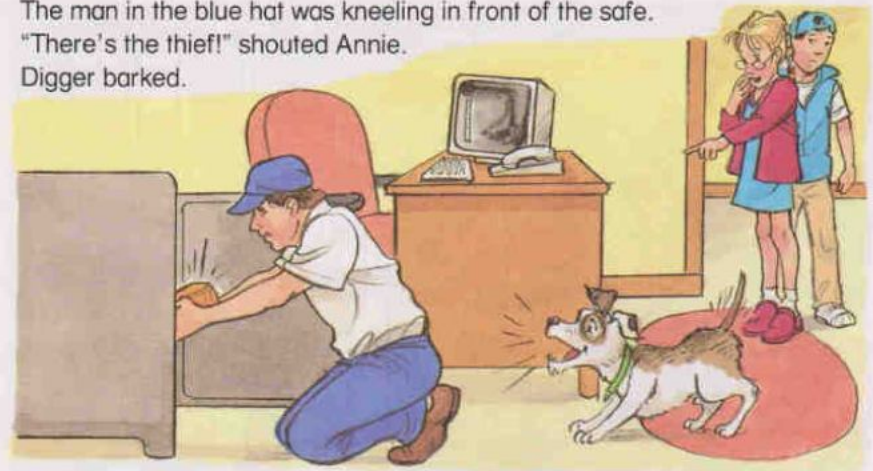
