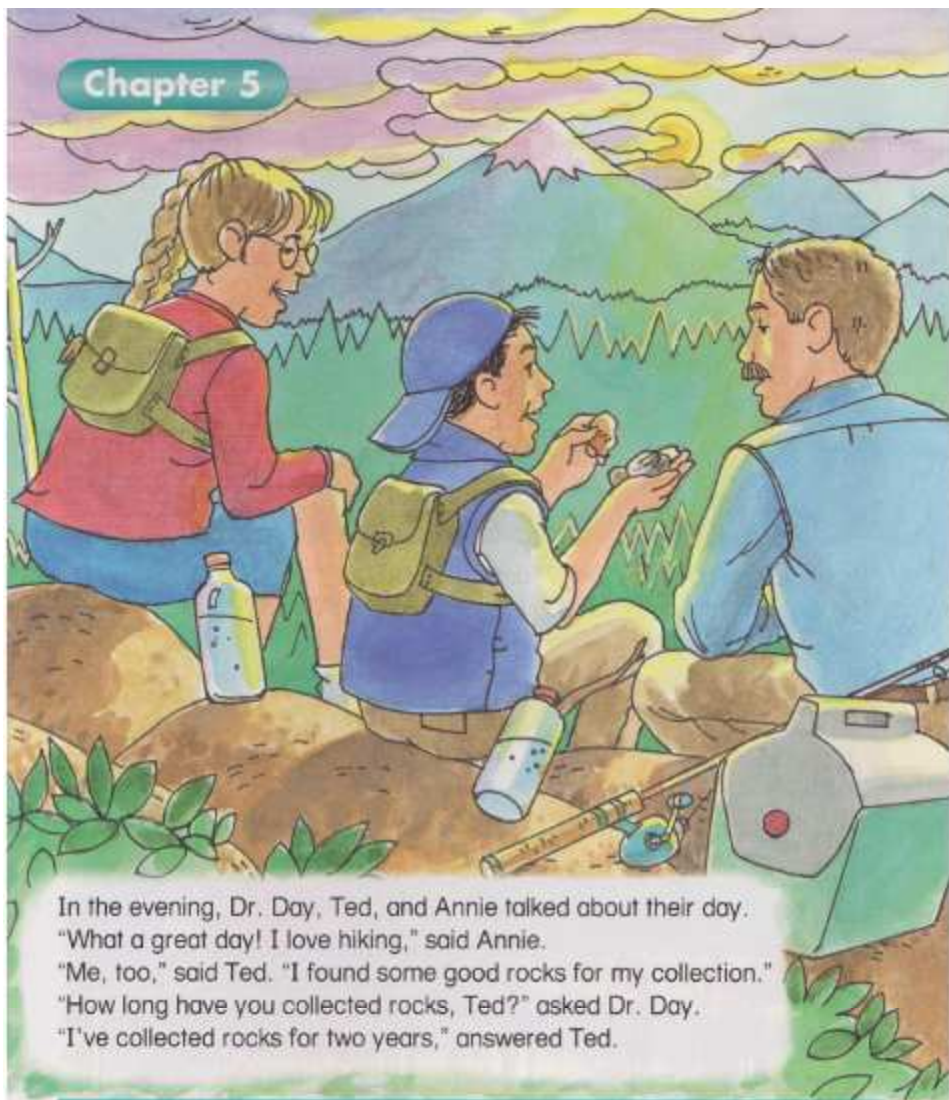


Chapter 5

Annie, Ted, and Dr. Day were walking on the trail when Annie said, "Look! There's someone under that tree!" She was scared.



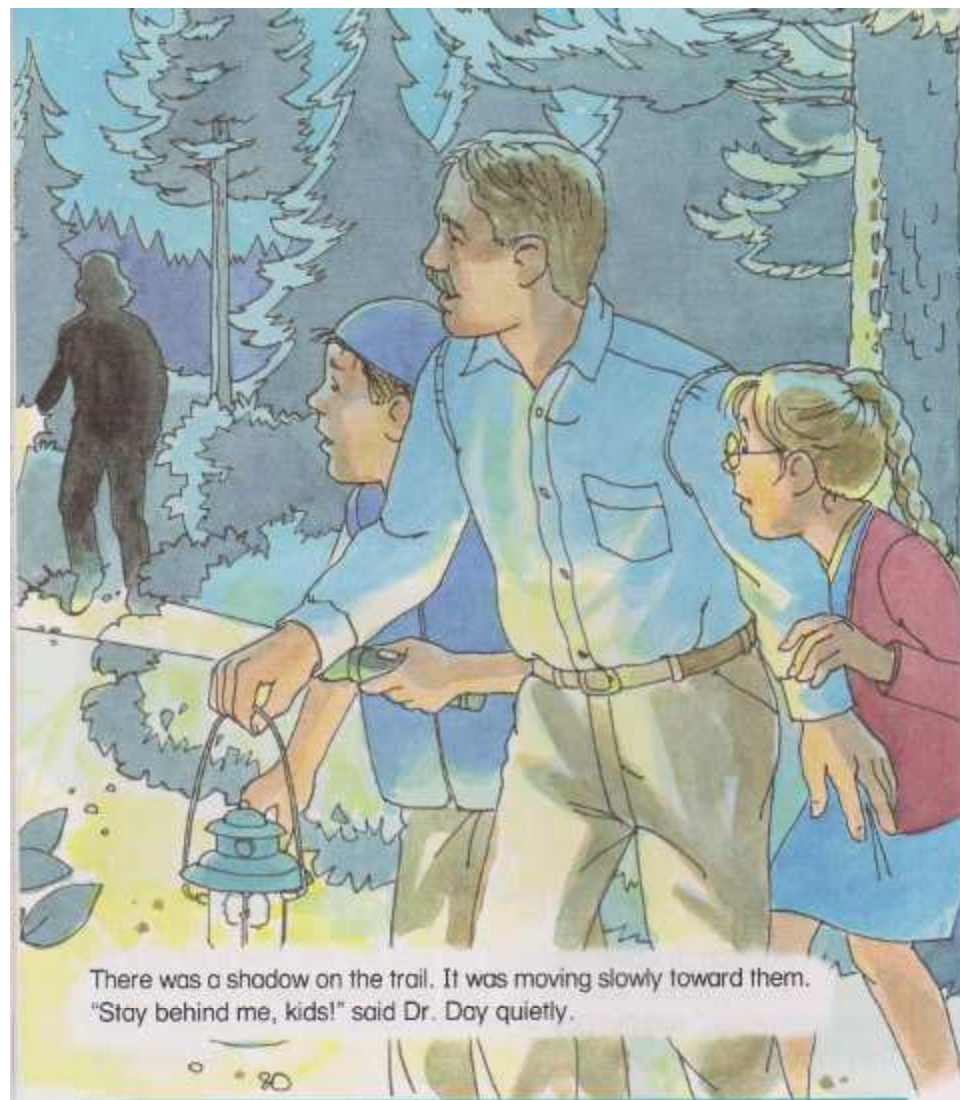
It wasn't a person. It was a sign.
