**Lyle:** Okay. Let's listen to **music!**

**Jay:** I want to play **outside**, not **inside.**

**Lyle:** Okay. Let's play with **fireworks!**

**Jay:** Playing with fireworks is **dangerous.**

**Lyle:** Okay. Let's go to the park and **play catch** with my **Frisbee.**

**Jay:** That's a great idea!

Usually a noun is the subject of a sentence.

If you have a **verb+ing**, it can be the subject of a sentence too!

**\*If a word ends in e, don't write the e when you add -ing.**

- **Wrong: Writeing (x)**
- **Right: Writing**
  
- **Wrong: Practiceing (x)**
- **Right: Practicing**
