Peter: That's **disgusting**! I'm going to tell my mother!



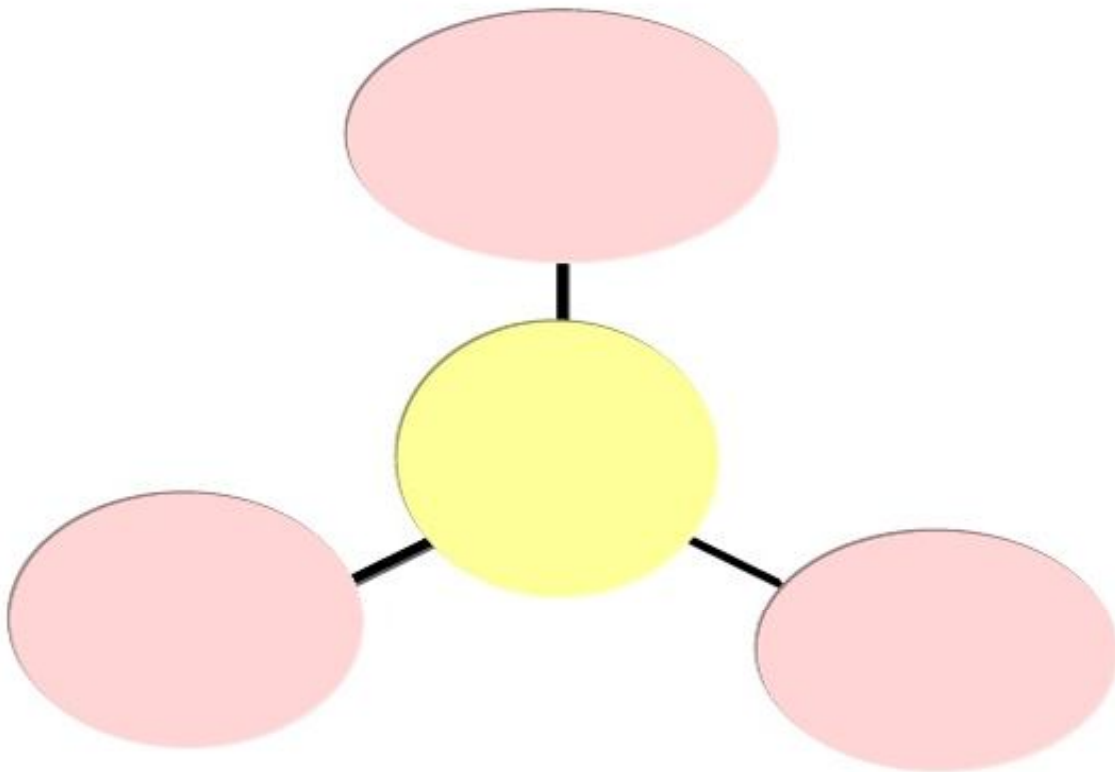
