\*When you add -s to a word that ends in s, sh, ch, x, or z (buzz, miss, catch), you have to add "es".

Wrong: washs (x)Right: washes

I wish > He wishes
You catch > She catches
They miss > It misses
We tax > He taxes
I sketch > She sketches
