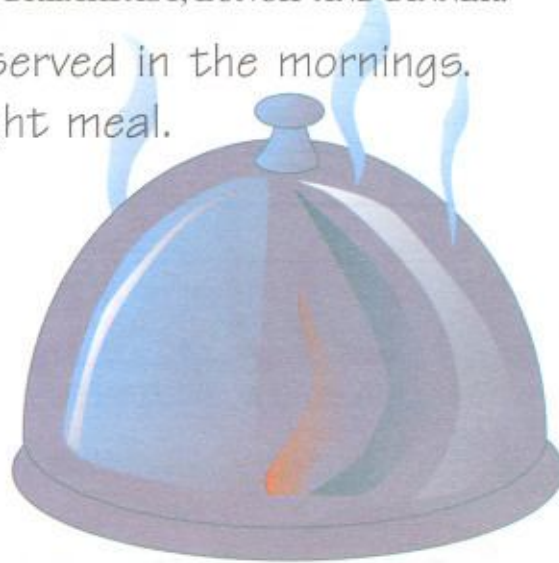


WE HAVE THREE MEALS EVERYDAY: BREAKFAST, LUNCH AND DINNER.

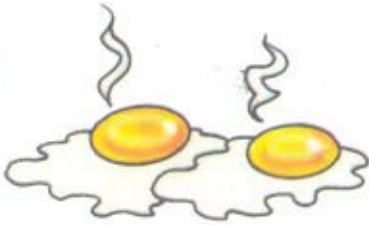

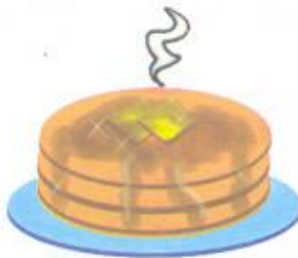

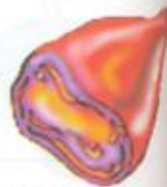
