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How do we express *time* in English? We use the prepositions **at**, **on**, and **in**!

A. At

	Pattern	Example		
Clock	at + clock time	School starts at 9:00.Come to my house at 7:30 pm.		
Time	at + noon	• We eat lunch at noon.		
	at + midnight	 I am usually asleep at midnight. 		
Other	at + night	• We watch TV at night.		
Times	at + dinnertime / lunchtime	 Take off your hat at dinnertime. She wants pizza at lunchtime. 		


















	Pattern	Example
Days	on + day	 We have free time on Monday. I play baseball on Thursdays. They unwrap presents on Christmas Day. I eat chocolate cake on my birthday.
	on + the weekend / weekends	 He has hockey practice on the weekend. I study on (the) weekends.
Dates on + date		 She has class on September 10. I am going to a party on the first of July. He has a doctor's appointment on Monday, December 2. They got a new dog on January 10, 2014.



















	in + the morning	 I study in the morning. 	
Time of Day	in + the afternoon	 They go to day care in the afternoon. 	
0. 247	in + the evening	 He plays video games in the evening. 	
Months	in + month	 My birthday is in June. 	
& Years	in + year	• She went to Disneyland in 2014.	
Seasons	in + season	We go camping in the summer.They like to ski in the wintertime.

We use **ordinal numbers** to say the date.

My birthday is on *February 12*.

- Write February 12 or February 12th.
- Say "February twelfth."


