## Talking about School and School Subjects - Useful Expressions


#### Level/Type of school

Subject + **be** + **in** + level/grade/type of school

- •I am in grade 2.
- •I am in elementary school. (also called "grade school" or "public school")
- •Lesley is in junior high.
- •They are in high school.
- •He is in college.
- •She is in university.
- •She is in second year.
- \*post-secondary = college or university

## Other ways of describing grades/levels/schools

- •I go to private school.
- •He goes to Catholic school.
- •I go to McClellan Heights High.
- •She goes to Wilson Elementary.
- •She attends public school.
- •I am a senior/junior.
- •I have one more year of secondary school. (high school)
- •This is my last year of junior high.
- •This is my **first** year of college.



#### **Subjects**

- •I like math and science.
- •I don't like history.
- •I am taking English literature.
- •He is studying biology.
- •She is majoring in sciences.

#### **Teachers**

- •I have Mrs. Cohen.
- •Sally has Mr. Miller for math.
