## School

Look at these pictures. Say something about them.



**Maria and John are schoolmates at the university.**

John has always liked going to school, too. In kindergarten John liked to sing songs. In elementary school he liked to read books. In junior high school he liked to learn math, also. In high school his favorite subjects were history and science but he didn't like to study English or math. John is a good student too, but sometimes he is a little lazy. Sometimes he doesn't study hard enough.

**Maria:** *Well, study hard and good luck.*

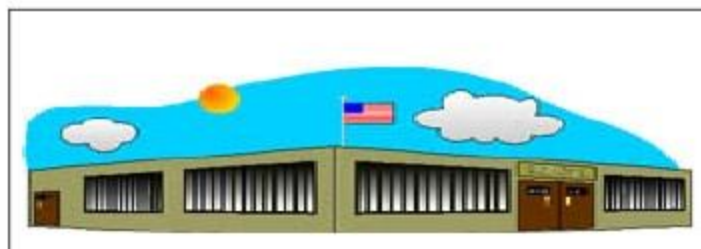
**John:** *Thanks, Maria. Good luck with your report.*
