adult	NOUN An adult is a fully-grown person or animal.
baby	NOUN A baby is a very young child.
beautiful	ADJECTIVE A beautiful person is very nice to look at.
boring	ADJECTIVE Someone or something that is boring is not at all interesting.
boy	NOUN A boy is a male child.
clever	ADJECTIVE Someone who is clever is intelligent and can think and understand quickly
girl	NOUN A girl is a female child.
happy	ADJECTIVE Someone who is happy feels pleased.
little	ADJECTIVE Something that is little is small.
man	NOUN A man is an adult male human.
nice	ADJECTIVE If something is nice, it is attractive, pleasant, or enjoyable.
blo	ADJECTIVE Someone who is old has lived for many years and is not young.
sad	ADJECTIVE If you are sad, you feel unhappy.
short	ADJECTIVE Someone who is short is not tall.
slim	ADJECTIVE If you are slim, your body is thin in an attractive way.
small	ADJECTIVE If something is small, it is not large.
tall	ADJECTIVE If someone is tall, they are higher than most other people.
tired	ADJECTIVE If you are tired, you feel that you want to rest or sleep.
woman	NOUN A woman is an adult female human being.
young	ADJECTIVE A young person, animal, or plant has not lived for very long.






