boat	NOUN A boat is a small ship.	
bus	NOUN A bus is a large motor vehicle that carries passengers.	
car	NOUN A car is a motor vehicle with space for about five people.	
drive	verse When you drive, you control the movement and direction of a car or other vehicle.	
driver	NOUN A driver is the person who drives a car.	
fly	VERB If you fly somewhere, you travel there in an aircraft.	

	holiday	NOUN A holiday is a period of time when you relax and enjoy yourself away from home.
	hotel	NOUN A hotel is a building where people pay to sleep and eat meals.
	leave	WERB If you leave a place or a person, you go away from them.
	plane	NOUN A plane is a vehicle with wings and engines that can fly.
M	station	NOUN A station is a place where trains stop so that people can get on or off.
욕	taxi	NOUN A taxi is a car with its driver, who you pay to take you where you want to go.
Finde	ticket	NOUN A ticket is a small piece of paper that shows that you have paid to go somewhere or to do something.
e	train	NOUN A train is a long vehicle that is pulled by an engine along a railway.
Nord Bow	travel	WERB If you travel, you go from one place to another, often to a place that is far away.
크	visit	WERB If you visit someone, you go to see them in order to spend time with them.
