

# Phrases with do, get, go, have, make and take

## Do and Make

These are some common ways to use do and make:

do + activity	I have to <b>do</b> my homework.  We <b>did</b> exercise 6 from our English book.	
make + food	He <b>made</b> a cake for me. I often <b>make</b> bread.	

## Get

These are some common ways to use get:

get = receive	He got lots of presents.
get = buy	I got a new coat.
get = arrive	We got home late.
get = travel	Let's <b>get</b> the bus.  We <b>got</b> a train to London.
get up = get out of bed	What time do you get up?

## Go

These are some common ways to use go:

go + activity	Shall we go swimming?	
go by + vehicle	We went by bus. He usually goes by car.	
go to + place	She went to China. I want to go to the theatre.	
go for + activity	Let's go for a walk.	

### Have

These are some common ways to use have:

have + description of a body part	He <b>has</b> blue eyes. She <b>has</b> very long legs.
have + illness	He <b>had</b> a cold. She <b>had</b> a headache.
have + food or drink	Let's have a cup of tea.  He had pizza for lunch.
have + action	I need to have a shower.
have + holiday	We <b>had</b> a holiday in Wales. You need to <b>have</b> a holiday.

# Take

These are some common ways to use take:

take + object	I <b>took</b> my mobile phone. You should <b>take</b> an umbrella.
take + person	I <b>took</b> the kids to the park.  Can you <b>take</b> John to his football match?
take + photo	She took a photo of the house.
take + activity	I need to take a shower.
