Grammar Notes

A. Introduction

An adjective is a word that describes (gives information about) a noun.

Adjectives can describe a person, place, or thing. They can also show a person's opinion or feeling.

B. Patterns

Adjectives have two sentence patterns in English.

#	Pattern	Adjective Placement	Examples
1	adjective + noun	before a noun	 She has a red car. (red describes the noun car) The lazy student doesn't do his homework. (lazy describes the noun student)
2	be + adjective	after the verb "to be" (is, am, are)	 My brother is happy. (happy describes the noun brother) Those jeans are expensive. (expensive describes the noun jeans)











Grammar Notes cont.

C. Suffixes

In English, we add a suffix (ending) to a noun or a verb to make an adjective.

Suffix	Example
-able	lovable
-al	logical
-ant	important
-ed	excited
-ent	independent
-ful	careful
-ible	sensible
-ic	energetic
-ing	exciting
-ive	attractive
-less	careless
-ous	dangerous
- y	healthy

Note #1:

Not all adjectives have a suffix.

Note #2:

The -ly suffix is usually for adverbs (words that describe verbs), but there are a few adjectives that end in -ly.

friendly
daily
yearly
costly
weekly
hourly
lonely
monthly
early

Note #3:

Some words are the same as an adjective or an adverb.

- He is a **fast** learner. (adjective, describes the noun learner)
- She runs **fast**. (adverb, describes the verb runs)
- She is a **hard** worker. (adjective, describes the noun worker)
- He studies **hard**. (adverb, describes the verb studies)


