







A. Pattern

This English sentence pattern is often used to describe the location of objects:

There + is + a + [noun] + [preposition] + the + [noun].



There is a lamp on the end table.



There is a painting above the sofa.



2 Grammar Notes cont.

B. Take Note!

Some English prepositions have similar meanings.

Next to and beside have the same meaning.

Above and over have similar meanings, but over is often used for movement.

Under, beneath, and below have similar meanings.




The toaster is **next to** the kettle.

The toaster is **beside** the kettle.



There is a painting **above** the sofa.

The dog jumped **over** the coffee table.



The cat is **under** the bed.


The cat is **beneath** the bed.
