

 Count Dracula is a vampire. He is **fictional**. Bram Stoker wrote a novel about this **character**. He based Dracula on a real **prince** from Transylvania named "Vlad the Impaler."
- Transylvania is a real place in Romania. Its name means "the land beyond the forests." There is a famous castle there called Bran Castle. It is in the Carpathian Mountains. Many tourists **believe** this was Prince Vlad's castle in the 15th century. They call it "Dracula's Castle." This is a myth.
- Prince Vlad's real home is at the top of a hill in the Transylvanian Alps. There are a hundred steps to the top. It fell apart long ago. Romanians hope to fix it up one day. Some wanted to build "Dracula Land." They thought a tourist attraction would help Romania's economy.

Did you know that Prince Charles of Great Britain is related to Prince Vlad? Prince Charles thought Dracula Land was a bad idea. He helped convince Romanians not to build a theme park in Transylvania.
