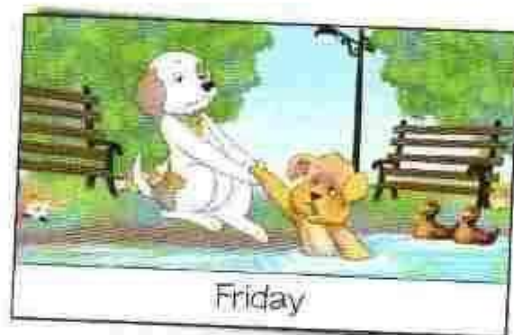


Digger's Diary

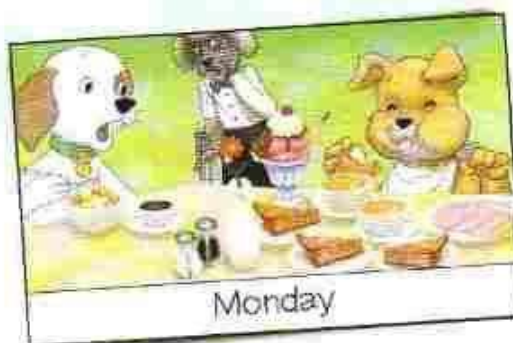

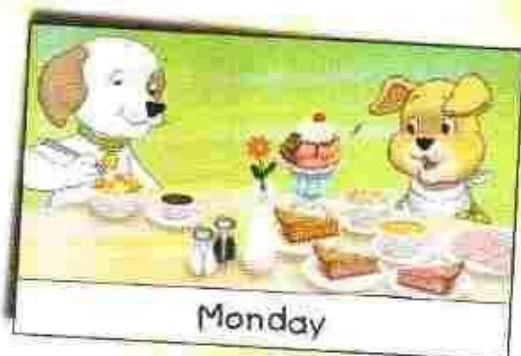
