Hibernation

It is rare to see bats, mice, snakes, or bears in winter. This is because they hibernate. Hibernation is when an animal sleeps all winter.

When an animal hibernates, it usually goes to sleep in the fall. Then, in the spring, it wakes up. An animal will do this because there is not much food in winter. Therefore, it goes to sleep.

The animal will gather and eat a lot of food. It does this to prepare for such a long sleep. It does not eat while it is hibernating.

At the end of fall, it is usually fat. Then it goes into its warm shelter. There are many kinds of shelters. Typical ones are caves, holes, or empty trees. The shelter protects the animal from the cold.

The animal usually sleeps for five months. When it wakes up, it is hungry. So, the animal eats. Then it all starts again!

How Animals Protect Themselves

- 1) Have you ever walked in the grass and smelled something terrible? The smell might be skunk spray. A skunk will spray something that attacks it. 2) It can shoot its spray very far. It makes everything smell horrible. It is hard to clean from fur. A sprayed animal will smell for weeks. A skunk will use its spray to stop from being attacked.
